MORE BUFFALOES ROTATE-----

IN THE REGIMENTAL CP AREA TODAY LT. COL. CLYDE R. RUSSELL, REGIMENTAL EXECUTIVE OFFICER, BID FAREWELL TO 118 MEN AS THEY LEFT FOR ROTATION TO THE UNITED STATES. IN A CEREMONY PRECEDING T. COL. RUSSELL'S ADDRESS, PFC ARTHUR T. DAY OF "G" CO. WAS AWARDED THE SILVER STAR, WHILE SGT JAMES T. LINESAY, HQS 1ST BN, AND CPL DUANE JONES HQS2HQ5 WERE BOTH AWARDED THE ARMY COMMENDATION RIBBON.

CONTENTS OF RED MESSAGE GIVEN--

THE CONTENTS OF THE MESSAGE DELIVERED TO UNITED NATIONS LIAISON OFFICERS LAST WEDNESDAY BY THE COMMUNISTS, HAS BEEN MADE PUBLIC. IN SUBSTANCE IT WAS IDENTICAL TO THE MESSAGE BROADCAST OVER THE PEIPING RADIO THAT SAME MORNING. IN THAT BROADCAST THE REDS SAID GENERAL RIDGWAY'S PROPOSAL OF CHANGING THE SITE OF PEACE TALKS WAS UNACCEPTABLE AND UNSATISFACTORY. THE REDS ALSO DEMANDED THAT THE UN ALSO PUT AN END TO THE SO CALLED VIOLATION OF THE NEUTRAL AGREEMENT.

MAC ARTHUR WOULD RUN FOR PRESIDENT

ONE OF GENERAL MAC ARTHUR'S CLOSE FRIENDS SAYS THAT THE GENERAL WILL NOT SEEK THE REPUBLICAN PRESIDENTIAL NOMINATION. A REPORT WAS TOLD THAT THE GENERAL WOULD RUN ONLY IF THE REPUBLICAN CONVENTION DRAFTS HIM.

SENATE APPROVES MILITARY BILL---

THE SENATE HAS PASSED THE \$1 BILLION DOLLAR MILITARY APPROPRIATIONS BILL. 20 BILLION WILL GO TO THE ARMY. A LIKE AMOUNT WILL GO TO THE AIR FORCE AND THE NAVY WILL GET 15 BILLION.

ARMY FIGURES-----

FOR THE 1ST TIME IN THE HISTORY OF THE ARMY IT IS FIGHTING, MOBILIZING AND DEMOBILIZING ALL AT ONCE. THE ARMY'S VICE CHIEF OF STAFF, GENERAL HALL, SAID THE ARMY HAS CLIMBED FROM ABOUT 600,000 MEN TO 1,500,000 SINCE THE FIGHTING STARTED IN KOREA. HE SAID ABOUT 50% OF THE NEW STRENGTH HAS BEEN PUT INTO COMBAT UNITS AND ABOUT 20% INTO COMBAT SUPPORT UNITS. AT THE SAME TIME, MEN ARE BEING ROTATED, WHILE OTHERS ARE BEING SENT TO EUROPE.
