UN PATROLS SEIZE LIMITED OBJECTIVES

UNITED NATIONS GROUND FORCES ALONG THE BATTLE FRONT IN KOREA YESTERDAY MAINTAINED POSITIONS AND PATROLLED. IN WEST CENTRAL KOREA YESTERDAY AN ENEMY PLATOON SIZE PROBING ATTACK WAS REPULSED BY FRIENDLY FORCES. IN

THE WESTERN SECTOR TWO UNITED NATIONS UNITS ADVANCED TO SECURE OBJECTIVES WITHOUT ENEMY RESISTANCE. POOR FLYING WEATHER RESTRICTED THE OPERATION OF LAND BASED AIR CRAFT OVER KOREA YESTERDAY. LIGHT BOMBERS ATTACKED TROOP AND GUN POSITIONS AND ALSO DESTROYED ENEMY SUPPLY DUMPS NEAR THE BATTLE FRONT. MEDIUM BOMBERS STRUCK ENEMY BUILD UP AREAS ON BOTH SIDES OF THE KOREAN PENINSULA AND ALSO BLASTED SOME RAIL BRIDGES.

CHILDRÉ BROUGHT TO KOREA WITH HIM A SMALL CONFEDERATE FLAG HE CARRIED THROUGHOUT WORLD WAR II. WHEN HE ASSUMED COMMAND OF THE COMPANY, HE AND HIS FIRST SERGEANT, SFC. ALBERT COLEMAN OF COTTONDALE, FLA., DECIDED TO FLY THE BANNER ALONG WITH THE NATIONAL COLORS.

APPARENTLY THE FAME OF THE CONFEDERATE ENSIGN HAS SWEEPED TO THE ORIENT. SERGEANT FIRST CLASS JOHN F. HOSKINS, BIRMINGHAM, ALA., AND MASTER SERGEANT HENRY A. RANDALL OF SELMA, ALABAMA WERE SHOPPING FOR THE COMPANY IN SEOUL WHEN THE REGIMENT WAS IN RESERVE RECENTLY. UPON ENTERING A KOREAN SHOP THEY WERE PLEASANTLY SURPRISED TO FIND A DIXIE BANNER HANGING ON THE WALL. THE TWO "BUFFALOES" TALKED THE NATIVES INTO SELLING IT AND IT NOW FLIES OVER "L" COMPANY'S POSITIONS.

"WE GOT ABOUT 106 MEN IN THE COMPANY FROM GOOD OLD DIXIE," CHILDRÉ DRAWLED. "THIS IS ONE WAR THE SOUTH IS GONNA WIN AND NO MISTAKE ABOUT IT!"

DEAL DIRECT-CHURCHILL

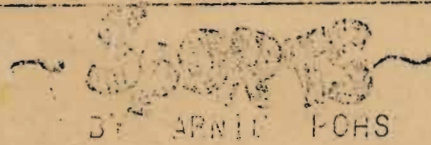
PRIME MINISTER WINSTON CHURCHILL OF ENGLAND ANNOUNCED YESTERDAY THAT BRITAIN WILL FIGHT IF NECESSARY, TO STAY IN THE SUEZ CANAL ZONE AND CALLED FOR DIRECT NEGOTIATIONS WITH MARSHAL JOSEPH STALIN IN AN ATTEMPT TO END THE COLD WAR. CHURCHILL OUTLINED THE POLICIES OF THE GOVERNMENT IN A SPEECH READ AT A JOINT SESSION OF PARLIAMENT IN THE KING'S NAME AND LATER IN A SPEECH OF HIS OWN IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS. HE SAID, "OUR GREATEST HOPE IN INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS IS TO END THIS 'COLD-WAR' BY NEGOTIATIONS AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL FROM STRENGTH AND NOT FROM WEAKNESS." IF A MEETING WITH STALIN DOES PRODUCE FRIENDSHIP BETWEEN THE EAST AND WEST, PRIME MINISTER CHURCHILL SAID, "WE'LL STOP THE TERIBLE WASTE AND STRAIN OF THE COLD WAR."



TRUMAN TO SPEAK

PRESIDENT TRUMAN WILL MAKE AN IMPORTANT AND WHAT IS EXPECTED TO BE A HIGHLY SIGNIFICANT FOREIGN POLICY ADDRESS TODAY. IT HAS BEEN SPECULATED IN WASHINGTON THAT THE PRESIDENT'S SPEECH MAY OUTLINE A NEW DISARMAMENT PROGRAM.
