The blue shield is representative of the Infantry. The White Stone 'all is symbolic of the Regiment's assault on the famous stone wall in the Battle of Fredericksburg during the Civil War. The 'White Cross Fletches' is the badge of Sykes' Division to which the Regiment belonged during the Civil War - 1861-1865. The five bastioned fort was the badge of the 5th Army Corps in Gains - 1898. The origin of the buffalo can be traced to the Korean Conflict when, during the command of Colonel, now General, William W. "Buffalo Bill" Quinn, it was used as the 17th Infantry's radio call sign. It has been the 17th's trademark.

MOTTO: Truth and Courage.

Organized 6 July 1861, fostered by the Civil War, toughened by the Indian Wars and the Philippine Insurrection, proven in battle during World War II and the Korean Conflict, the 17th Infantry Regiment stands as a proud member of the Regular Army. Born of men of Maine and New Hampshire, the 17th Infantry Regiment initially answered the call to serve the Union Flag during the Civil War. The fame of the 17th began in 1863 when it joined Major General George Sykes' famous fighting Division "Sykes Regulars". Through the summer of 1863, from the courageous defense of Gaines Mill to the brutal assault on Fredericksburg, the 17th Infantry proved itself again and again in fierce combat. Yet, on 7 July 1863, in the twisted and crazy ravine known as Devil's Den, the regiment was to meet its most savage test. Acting as part of the Union forces defending Little Round Top, key to the Union flank, the "17th" made the savage charge of Major General John B. Hood's Confederate Division. Through the day and into the night, the Regiment repelled the Confederate onslaught, in fierce hand-to-hand combat. In the morning when the smoke and haze of battle cleared, the Union flag still stood on Little Round Top - the 17th Infantry Regiment had held the vital Union flank.

Following the Civil War, the 17th Infantry Regiment led the expansion of the nation westward. During the Indian Campaign, the men of the 17th clashed with the tribes of Cheyenne and Sioux, guarded railroad construction parties, and assisted the government mail service along its western route. The citizens of Kansas again called the 17th Infantry in June of 1866 when the Regiment distinguished itself as part of the assault force on Cope in the battles of El Dorado and Hamburgo. Following the war with Cope, in August of 1866, the 17th returned to California Forts, Calif. In January 1899, the Regiment was once again called to arms and distinguished itself in the defense of the city of Manila, Philippines. The sea lion, taken from the Spanish coat of arms, appears on the colors of the 17th Infantry as the symbol of the heroic defense of that city. During World War I, the Regiment guarded German prisoners and trained replacements for the new units which were being formed. On 12 December 1940, the Regiment was moved to Fort Ord, California and joined Major General J.W. "Pingee Joe" Stillwell's 7th Infantry Division.

The bloody fighting of World War II again found the 17th Infantry on the front. The Regiment, fighting as part of the 7th Division, first saw action against the Japanese forces entrenched on the Islands in the Arctic. After weeks of costly fighting, the 17th helped to route the Japanese from their emplacements on the jagged peaks of the Arctic. Finally, with the assault on Iwo Jima, August 15 1945, the Japanese threat to the North American continent was crushed. On 21 January 1946, the Regiment was again committed to action - its target, this time, was the Kwajalein Atoll, the principal Japanese base in the Marshall Islands. The Kwajalein Campaign lasted a total of seven days and is on record as being one of the most successful amphibious operations of World War II. After Kwajalein, the 17th Infantry returned to Hawaii for intensive jungle training - its next objective would be Leyte, Philippines.

On the morning of 20 October 1944, the 17th Infantry, as part of the 7th Infantry Division plunged ashore on the island of Leyte. Acting first as a Division reserve unit, then as the spearhead of the attack, the 17th Infantry waded through steaming swamps and jungles toward the strategic

airfield of San Polo. Sweeping through San Polo on 24 October 1944, the Regiment continued the advance of the 7th Infantry Division westward. By the first days of November 1944, the 17th secured its initial objective, the town of Dagami; but the Regiment did not rest - it was ordered to move west and north. This time the objective was the seaport of Ormoc and the Japanese reinforcements being landed there. Hill 918 was its first objective. Days and weeks of bitter fighting followed and it was not until 5 December 1944 that the men of the 17th Infantry stood atop Hill 918. Yet, this was the first of many hills which had to be taken on the way to Ormoc. Except for mopping up operations, this ended the 17th's part in General MacArthur's Philippine Campaign.

On Easter Sunday, 1 April 1945, the 7th Infantry Division plunged ashore on the beaches of Kadena, Okinawa - the 17th Infantry had begun its fourth campaign. Although unopposed on the initial landing, by 24 April 1945 the 17th was pitting the Japanese from their caves, tunnels, and pill boxes in vicious hand-to-hand combat. Finally near the end of June, the Japanese were defeated - the Battle of Okinawa had ended. The bitter fighting of World War II was over for the 17th Infantry Regiment. But, the 17th Infantry did not go home.

On 18 September 1945, the Regiment landed at the port of Inchon, Korea, to begin three years of occupation duties. It stood as the main bulwark between Russian aggression and the free world until 1948 when the Regiment was withdrawn from Korea and transferred to Japan, where it remained until the outbreak of the Korean Conflict in 1950.

The Korean Conflict erupted on Sunday morning, 25 June 1950. By mid-September, the North Koreans had assaulted deep into South Korea. On 29 October 1950 the Regiment landed at Iwon, North Korea. Landing unopposed, the "Buffalo" Regiment began its drive north and on 21 November 1950 reached the Manchurian border. But, shortly, the 17th Infantry "Buffaloes" were fighting for their lives. On 27 November 1950, the Chinese Communists entered the war. Bending its arms across the Yalu River, it surrounded the 17th. The 17th broke out and fought its way to Hungnam where it was evacuated to Pusan on the 17th of December 1950.

On 26 January 1951, the Chinese Communist Armies had driven the United Nations forces into a tight perimeter around Pusan. On 15 September 1951, the 17th stormed ashore at Inchon Harbor cutting the North Korean supply line. The 17th's initial objective was Seoul, the South Korean capital. By 19 September 1951, the capital had been liberated and the Regiment swung south to link up with the 1st Cavalry Division breaking out of Pusan. Following Operation Breakout, the Regiment moved to Pusan for extensive amphibious training.

The Regiment took part in the Summer-Fall Offensive, participating in Operation Killer, the Battle for Hill 850 and Old Baldy, the Punchbowl, Mindung-Ni Valley and Heartbreak Ridge. In July 1952, the Regiment organized "Operation Indicator", a raid designed to capture prisoners and obtain information pertaining to enemy positions. Then, in October 1952, the Iron Triangle Area, the 17th participated in the now famous, Battle of Triangle Hill and Sniper Ridge. In April 1953, the 17th took part in the savage fight on Outpost Pork Chop. On 27 July 1953, American and Communist negotiators signed the Armistice which ended the fighting on the Korean Peninsula.

Peace did not mean home for the now famous 17th Infantry Regiment "Buffaloes". The 17th moved to Camp Kaiser, South Korea where it remained until 15 November 1970 when the Regiment was reduced to zero strength as part of the reduction of U.S. forces in Korea. The Regimental Colors were moved to Camp Casey where they were maintained until 17 June 1971. On that day, the 1st Battalion (H) 17th Infantry was filled with personnel from the 2d Battalion (H) 23d Infantry and relocated to Camp Greaves and Liberty Bell for duty on the Demilitarized Zone in South Korea. In September 1972, the 17th moved to Camp Yokohama where it remained until 15 June 1976. On this date the Buffaloes removed to Camp House and again moved to Camp Casey in June 1976 where they continue to train and guard Freedom's Frontier.






