

Truce

ALLIED AND COMMUNIST REGOTIATORS HOPE TO COMPROMISE ON THREE DIFFERENCES HOLDING UP TRUCE REGOTIATIONS, THESE ISSUES ARE TRUCE INSPECTION, TROOP ROTATION AND ISLAND CONTROL.
